A total of 31 artificial insemination technicians have been passed out at Ruhengyere field station. These were drawn from districts and farms of Kabuki, Kamuli, Kisoro, Kakumira, Isingiro, Bukedea, Soroti, Kakira SW, Nakaseke, Mubende, Mbarara, Kiruhura, Kiboga, Kago, Rubona SF, Serere, Bulisa, Bulago SF, Kaberamaado, Aswa Ranch, Kiboga, Maruzi ranch, Njeru SF, Itakungiri and Wakiso. They will help the Government in extension of breeding services to the farmers. The state minister of agriculture in charge of animal industry, Bright Rwamirama, presided over the event. It was also witnessed by managing director of the National Animal Genetic Resources Centre and Data Bank and board members. Siraj Luwaga, the course co-ordinator, said all the trainees were well selected with sufficient background training, have been well "disciplined and have been urged to do a good job".
