



# Government passes out artificial inseminators

These were drawn from districts and farms of Kabaki, Kasuli, Kisoro, Kakumiro, Isingiro, Bukedea, Seroti, Kakiro SW, Nakaseke, Mureende, Mbarara, Kiruhura, Kiboga, Kago, Rubona SE, Serere, Bulisa, Bulago SE, Kachemanya, Aswa Ranch, Kiboga, Maruzi Ranch, Njeru SE, Rukungiri and Wakiso. They will help the Government in extension of breeding services to the farmers. The state minister of agriculture in charge of animal industry, Bright Rwamirama, presided over the event. It was also witnessed by managing director of the National Animal Genetic Resources Centre and Data Bank and board members.

Siraj Luwaga, the course co-ordinator, said all the trainees were well selected with sufficient background training, have been well "disciplined and have been urged to do a good job".


